PennsylvaniaPrimary Elections

Pennsylvania primary day is on **Tuesday, May 16.**

In the **New Hope/Solebury** area there are 5 school board positions on the ballot. There are 8 candidates — 3 Republicans and 5 Democrats, but they all cross-file, so it's important to know who your candidates are and what they represent.

In the **Central Bucks School District**, there are 11 candidates running for 5 seats. The current board makeup is 6 Republicans/3 Democrats (2 of the Republicans are affiliated with the Christian nationalist group, Moms for Liberty).
