Postcard Writing

An **August 8** Special Election aims to amend the Ohio Constitution (see below "News and Views" for an explanation) so that voter initiatives are more difficult to get onto ballots and for those that do, to change the simple majority rule to 60%. They're doing this to defeat a Pro-Choice measure going before voters in November.

When you have postcards and stamps on hand, here are the convenient ways to request **5** voters' addresses.
