| NJ State Legislature must convene regularly | Demand that our state legislators meet regularly August through October to plan how to blunt the many destructive consequences of the recently passed US budget bill. Our legislature is not planning to meet regularly until November. Please sign on to a petition asking the legislature to start addressing these issues now and not wait till November. |
| Pass the NJ Immigrant Trust Act | Pass the Immigrant Trust Act (Senate bill 3672; Assembly bill 4987): This bill would allow immigrants in NJ to seek public services without fear of deportation. The bill is stalled in the legislature due to a lack of support from state legislative leaders. We need to press the legislature to act. Click here to take action! |
