



Dear Friends,

Due to a low response rate, we're opening up our **"temperature check" survey** for one (1) additional week. Please give us your views of the NJ CD7 primary candidates by completing the survey — after reading this information.

Indivisible Lambertville/New Hope (ILNH) seeks to coordinate with other Indivisible groups across New Jersey's 7th Congressional District (CD7) to endorse a candidate ahead of the June primary. To do so, it's critical that we hear from *you*.

Our process will include a number of "temperature checks" to get a sense of our community's top 2 or 3 choices. This is the first one. The end goal is to arrive at a pre-primary endorsement of a single candidate — one who will fight for Indivisible values — and then use our collective power to flip the district.

As part of this process, it's important that you have access to information about the candidates. ILNH and other organizations have provided opportunities to help you determine who will be the fighter for democracy and social justice we need in Congress. 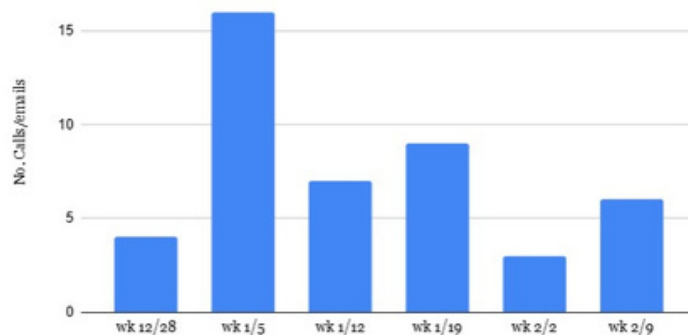
